






- 1. Equestrian armor of King Maximilian I, about 1490.
- 2. Pomp armor, allegedly of King Philip I of Castile, about 1506.




- 1. Pomp armor of King Ludwig II of Hungary, about 1515.
- 2. Armor of archduke Carl, later Emperor Carl V. Remains unfinished.






- 1. Norman helmet, 12th century.
